

National Level Three days Online Faculty Development Program

## **Objectives of the program:**

- To upgrade teaching skills and soft skills for effective conduct of lectures and practical's of new courses for students benefit.
- To develop distinct composite of knowledge, skill, and attitude and values that is essential to the build teaching practice for the successful delivery of new courses.

## Report:

A National Level three days Faculty Development Program was organized by the institute in collaboration with GCOPK entitled 'Effectual Execution of Second Year Diploma Course as per E.R. 2020' from 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2022 via online mode. The FDP experienced an overwhelming response from faculties of different institutions. Total more than 1000 participants including Principals & HODs registered for the program from various institutes of India. The workshop was inaugurated with the gracious presence of Mr. Vijay Patil, Invitee Executive Member Pharmacy Council of India and President MSPC, Dr. K. B. Burade, Principal, Government College of Pharmacy Karad and Mr. V.R. Shinde, Campus Director, LADCMIP, Masur. Introduction for the FDP were given by Mr. V. R. Shinde, which was followed by a key note address by Dr. K.B. Burade. During this event, eminent experts from academia guided the participants on various aspects of second year diploma in pharmacy courses for the successful

delivery of theory and practical of new courses. During the interaction session queries of the participants were well addressed by the speakers.

During this online 3 days Program, 6 sessions were organized on each course of diploma in pharmacy. During the first session, Dr. R. J. Dias, HOD, GCOP, Karad spoke on Orientation of Community pharmacy and Management course. These sessions focused on pedagogical aspects of teaching and how to effectively deliver practical content of CPM course. In the next session of the day, Mrs. D. S. Chakraborty, Vice Principal, Amababai Talim College of Pharm, Miraj oriented faculties on Hospital and Clinical pharmacy. On the second day of the program, Dr. K. U. Bansod, Lecturer, GCOP, Karad focused on all syllabus and exam pattern of Pharmacology course. During the next session, Prof V. D. Havaldar, Principal, Adarsh college of Pharmacy, Vita spoke on orientation of Pharmacy Laws and Ethics and guided the participants to familiarize with the outcome based learning methodology. On the third day, Mr. V. R. Shinde oriented on Pharmacotherapeutics and discussed in detail how to conduct theory as well as practical part. Dr. P. D. Argade, I/c HOD, GCOP, Jalgaon, and Mr. S. S. Pande, Lecturer, GCOP, Karad oriented faculties on biochemistry theory and practical part.

Participants' feedback claims that they found this FDP more beneficial. Many participants also requested to arrange similar FDPs in the future. An e-certificate was also issued to the participants who successfully completed the program.
